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NH Center for Nonprofits Announces Statewide Day of Giving on June 7

NH Gives Day Will Benefit Hundreds of Nonprofits in New Hampshire

CONCORD: The NH Center for Nonprofits is pleased to announce plans for the first statewide day of giving to take place on June 7. NH Gives Day will bring hundreds of nonprofits and their supporters together in a 24-hour online giving event designed to celebrate local nonprofits and amplify the generosity of New Hampshire citizens.

“NH Gives Day will be a special day that brings attention to the tremendous impact that nonprofits have in our lives,” said Kathleen Reardon, CEO of the NH Center for Nonprofits. “The day will connect people to causes they care about and make charitable giving a community event.”
