The Center Announces the High Impact Volunteer Engagement Participating Organizations

CONCORD, NH: The NH Center for Nonprofits, partnering with the NH Charitable Foundation, launched their High Impact Volunteer Engagement Program last month with ten NH nonprofits who were accepted into the year-long program after a competitive process.

“Each organization will spend the next 12 months working a project to move the dial on implementing high impact volunteer engagement within their organization,” noted Assistant Director Laurette Edelmann.

The groups will receive coaching, mentoring and training by the JFFixler Group, from Englewood, Colorado, throughout the twelve months. The program is designed to build the nonprofits’ capacity and increase their impact in the communities they serve through a pilot project to enhance highly skilled volunteer engagement in their organization.

The ten nonprofits are: Bhutanese Community of NH, Canterbury Shaker Village, Families in Transition, Home Health & Hospice Care, NH Citizen’s Alliance, Response to Sexual & Domestic Violence Program, Symphony NH, The Front Door Agency, The River Center, WISE.
